- **Ybyk Gorge**—Porous limestone canyon in Mangystau Region.
 - **Karaman-Ata Necropolis**—Historic necropolis with an underground mosque.
 - **Kyzylkup**—Colorful layered hills known as Tiramisu Canyon.
 - **Bokty Mountain**—Iconic solitary mountain in Mangystau.
 - **Bozjyra Mars Panorama – Bozjyra Valley**—Scenic viewpoint over desert cliffs.
 - **Bozjyra Dragon Crest – Bozjyra Valley**—Narrow limestone ridge formation.
 - **Bozjyra Fangs – Bozjyra Valley**—Twin white limestone peaks.

Detailed Day-by-Day Itinerary

Day 1. Aktau -Ybyk - Zhanaozen - Shakpakty Panorama - Kyzylkup (Tiramisu) Canyon

The first stop is **Ybyk Gorge**, where you'll walk through steep cliffs and winding passages that showcase the raw beauty of the desert canyons. From there, you'll continue to **Karaman-Ata Necropolis**, home to the largest underground mosque in Mangystau, dating back to the 11th century and steeped in spiritual and historical significance.

The final destination is **Kyzylkup, also known as Tiramisu Canyon**, famous for its layered cliffs resembling slices of the dessert. Here, you'll enjoy a peaceful evening camping under the stars.

-  **Distance:** 305 km on-road & 75 km off-road
-  **Duration:** 5 hours 30 minutes (driving time)
-  **Start Time:** 09:00 AM
-  **Accommodation:** Tent camping under the stars
-  **Meals:** Lunch & Dinner


Day 2. Bokty Mount - Bozjyra Mars Panorama - Bozjyra Crest Panorama - Bozjyra Fangs Formation

After breakfast in the yurt, you begin a more challenging but rewarding horseback journey toward **Song-Kol Lake**, one of Kyrgyzstan's most spectacular high-altitude lakes.


The route gradually ascends toward the **Jalgyz-Karagai Pass (3,300m)**. The climb is steep in parts, but the panoramic views of endless mountains and valleys make every moment worthwhile. At the top, you pause to rest the horses and enjoy your first distant view of the shimmering Song-Kol Lake.

From here, you descend toward the lake, passing nomadic camps, grazing horses, and wide alpine meadows. By midday, you arrive at the lakeshore where a fresh lunch is served at the yurt camp.

The afternoon is free to relax—walk along the shore, observe nomadic life, or simply enjoy the peaceful atmosphere of this remote paradise. At night, the sky opens into a spectacular display of stars.

 **Distance:** 265 km on-road & 82 km off-road

 **Duration:** 7 hours total driving time

 **Meals:** Breakfast and Lunch (no dinner provided)
