Day 1: Farap – Mary

Our representative will meet you at the Turkmen/Uzbek border “Alat” at 9:00. Transfer to Merv (253km, 5h) to meet the group.

Optional: Arrive at Ashgabat International Airport. Transfer to Mary to meet the group.

Start to explore ancient Merv – “Queen of the world”, was one of the most important capitals of Islam, along with Baghdad, Cairo and Damascus. Sightseeing of ancient Merv includes Greater Kyz Gala & Lesser Kyz Gala (VI-VII), Complex of Askhabs (VIII-XIV), Erk Gala (VI BC), Gyaur Gala (IV BC), Hoja Yusup Hamadani complex, Sultan Sanjar mausoleum, Muhamed Ibn Zeid mausoleum. After sightseeing, drive to Mary. Then you will see all the major buildings of Mary downtown. If time permits, you will also visit Mary Bazaar to see a variety of local products and the Russian Orthodox church (one of the oldest in Turkmenistan). Overnight in Mary hotel.

Day 2: Mary – Ashgabat (4h, 360km)

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast, drive to Ashgabat. Upon arrival, visit Horse Stable to see the national pride of Turkmen people – Akhalteke horses, the nicest horses in the world. 5000 years ago, Turkmens began to breed Akhalteke horses. The World’s unique breed was never mixed with other breeds. Such illustrious Emperors like Alexander the Great and Darius I desired to own Akhalteke horses. There are beautiful horses on the farm. Per superstition, every sick person who touches an Akhalteke horse will get well soon.

In the afternoon, you will have an Ashgabat city tour. In 2013, the Guinness Book of Records named Ashgabat a “white marbled city” – here you can see the biggest number of structures in the world made out of white marble. You will see the Wedding Palace, the modern “Yildyz” Hotel, the Ferris Wheel, the Constitution Monument, the Arch of Neutrality, the Monument and Park of Independence, Ertogrul Gazi Mosque, and Ashgabat Sports and Housing facilities. Overnight at the Ashgabat Sport Hotel.

Day 3: Ashgabat – Darvaza

Breakfast at the hotel. Free time till noon. Hotel check out and meet your guide for the drive to Darvaza Burning Gas Crater (276km, 4h). The Crater is also called “The Door to Hell”. The area is rich in natural gas. While drilling in 1971, Soviet geologists tapped into a cavern filled with natural gas. The ground beneath the drilling rig collapsed, leaving a large hole with a diameter of 60 m and 20 m. To avoid poisonous gas discharge, it was decided to burn it off. Geologists had hoped the fire would use all the fuel in a matter of days, but the gas is still burning today. In

the evening, watch the spectacular and fascinating view of the gas crater. BBQ dinner at Gas Crater. Overnight in Yurt camp.

Day 4: Darvaza – Dashoguz

Picnic-style breakfast. After breakfast, drive to the Turkmen/Uzbek Border Checkpoint (309km, 5h) to cross into Uzbekistan. Optional: Drive back to Ashgabat. Transfer to Ashgabat International Airport or to the hotel for an additional night.

1. *Due to changing road and traffic conditions, actual driving times may vary slightly from those mentioned in the program. Please note that all stated driving times do not include stops.*
 2. *Flight times are subject to change by Turkmenistan Airlines. Hand luggage allowance is 5 kg, and checked baggage allowance is 20 kg per person. Any excess baggage will be charged at approximately USD 2–3 per kg.*
 3. *If a traveller stays in Turkmenistan for more than 3 working days, the travel agency will register the stay and have the passport stamped by the local Tourist Board.*
 4. *An express COVID-19 PCR test will be conducted upon arrival, with a cost of approximately USD 33.*
 5. *A breakfast box will be provided in case of very early morning departures.*
 6. *Please carry small denominations of cash (USD 1, 5, and 10 notes) to facilitate and speed up visa and airport procedures. Banknotes must be clean, undamaged, and issued no earlier than 2009.*
 7. *Most locations accept only cash, and credit cards are often not accepted or may not work.*
 8. *To stay in contact with family, friends, or colleagues during your trip, we recommend downloading the IMO messaging app before arrival. Please also ensure your contacts install and are familiar with the app.*
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We may occasionally adjust the order of visits and activities (museums and sites) if required due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances. Any changes will be made with your comfort and overall experience in mind.
